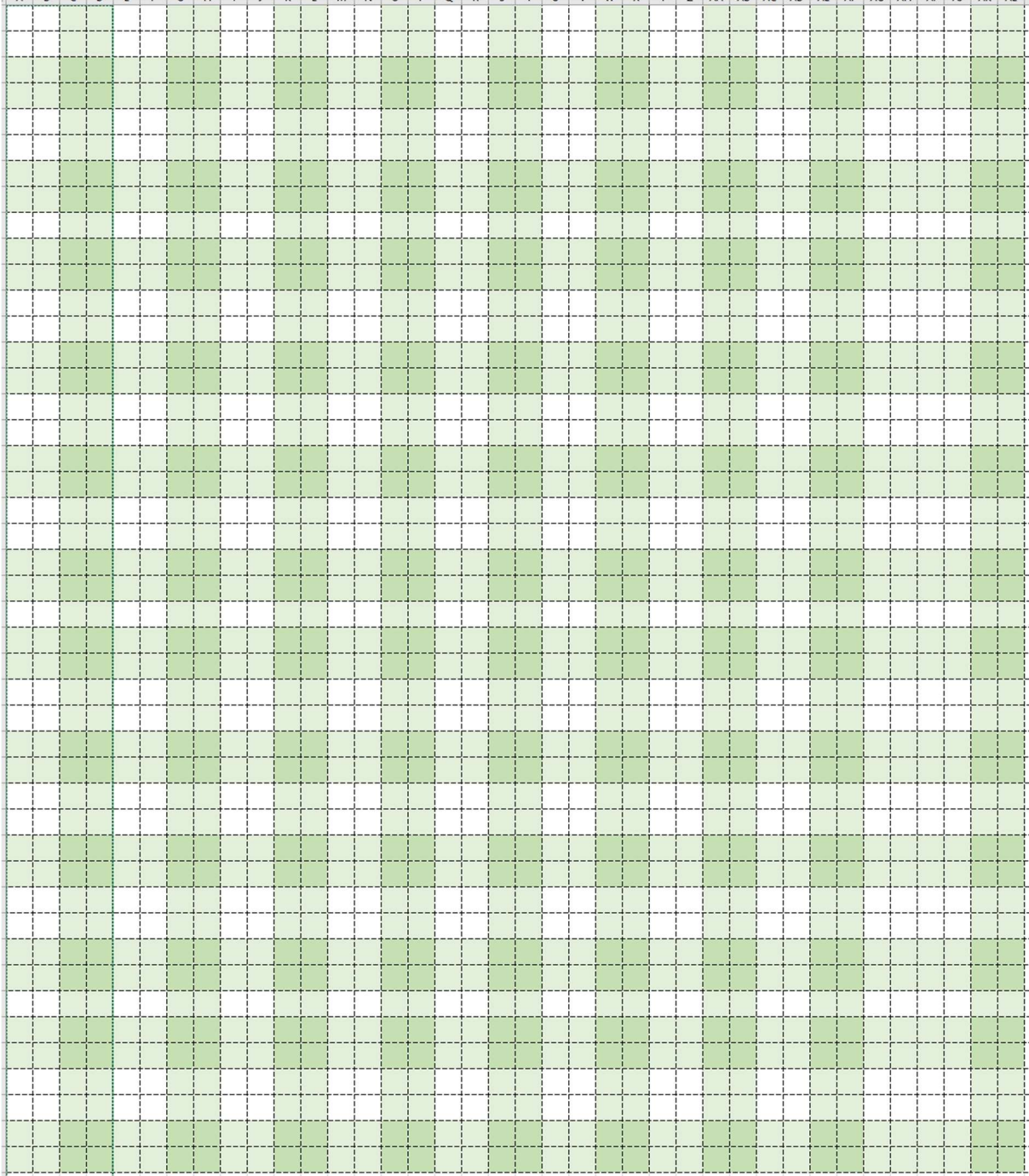

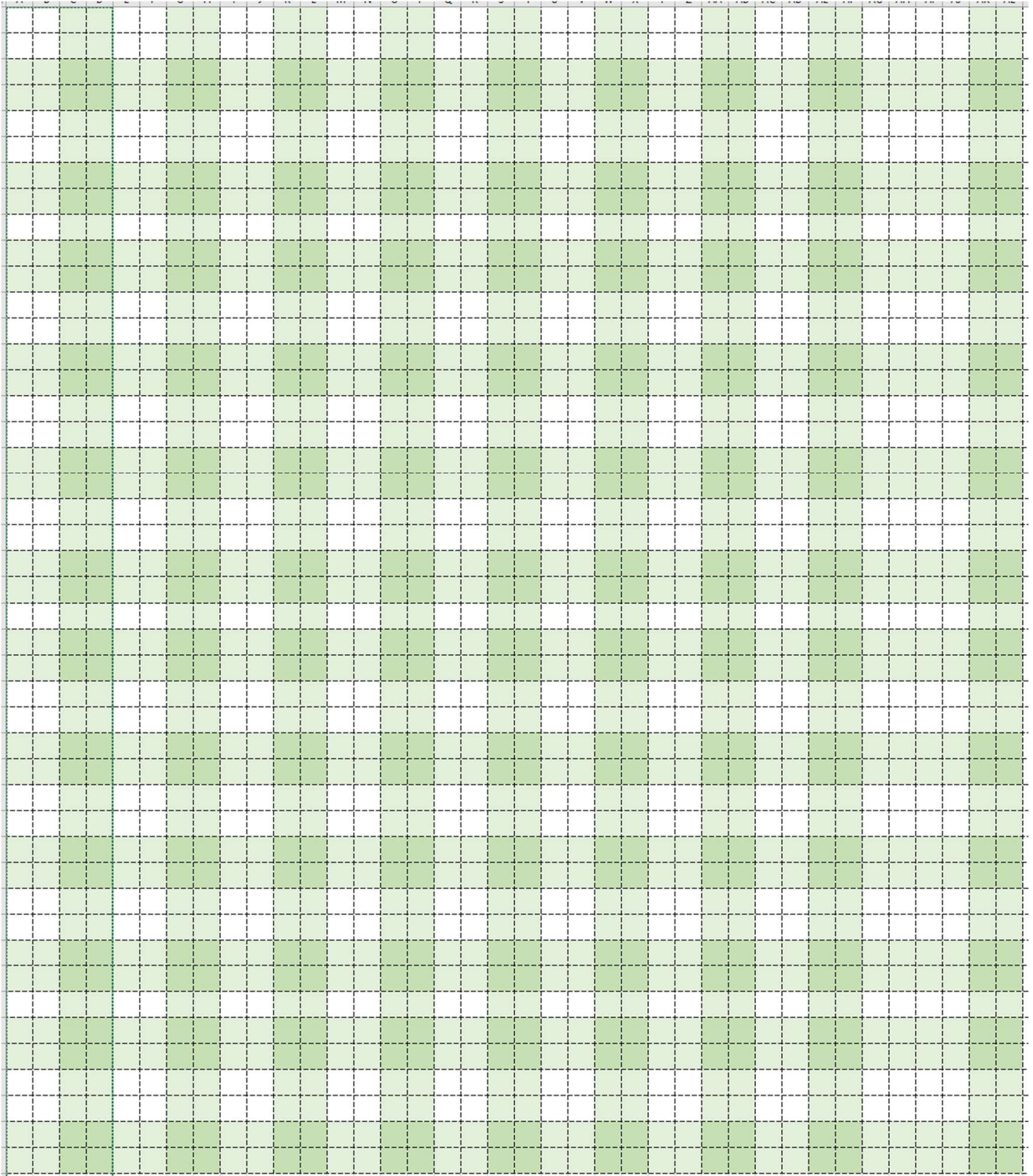

Instructions

- **Fill in the year and season fields on the layout page**
- **Set your scale; one square can be one square foot, 4 squares can represent 1 square foot, etc.**
- **Note N, E, S, W, water source location, existing beds and trellises, pathways, existing plants, areas of shade sun, or any other relevant location information that may determine what plants you plant in a specific location**
- **Reference the plant spacing chart to determine how much space each plant will need (note: check seed or plant labels for more specific spacing). You may also print the plant spacing page and cut out the icons to manually move around your layout**
